

# FOR THE SAFETY OF STUDENTS...

At our School Advisory Council meeting, concerns were raised regarding student safety during morning entry and afternoon dismissal. It was noted that too many cars are using the front door for drop-off/pick-up. This has caused congestion for our buses and has made our front entrance area more dangerous for students.

Our School Advisory Council is asking ALL families to:

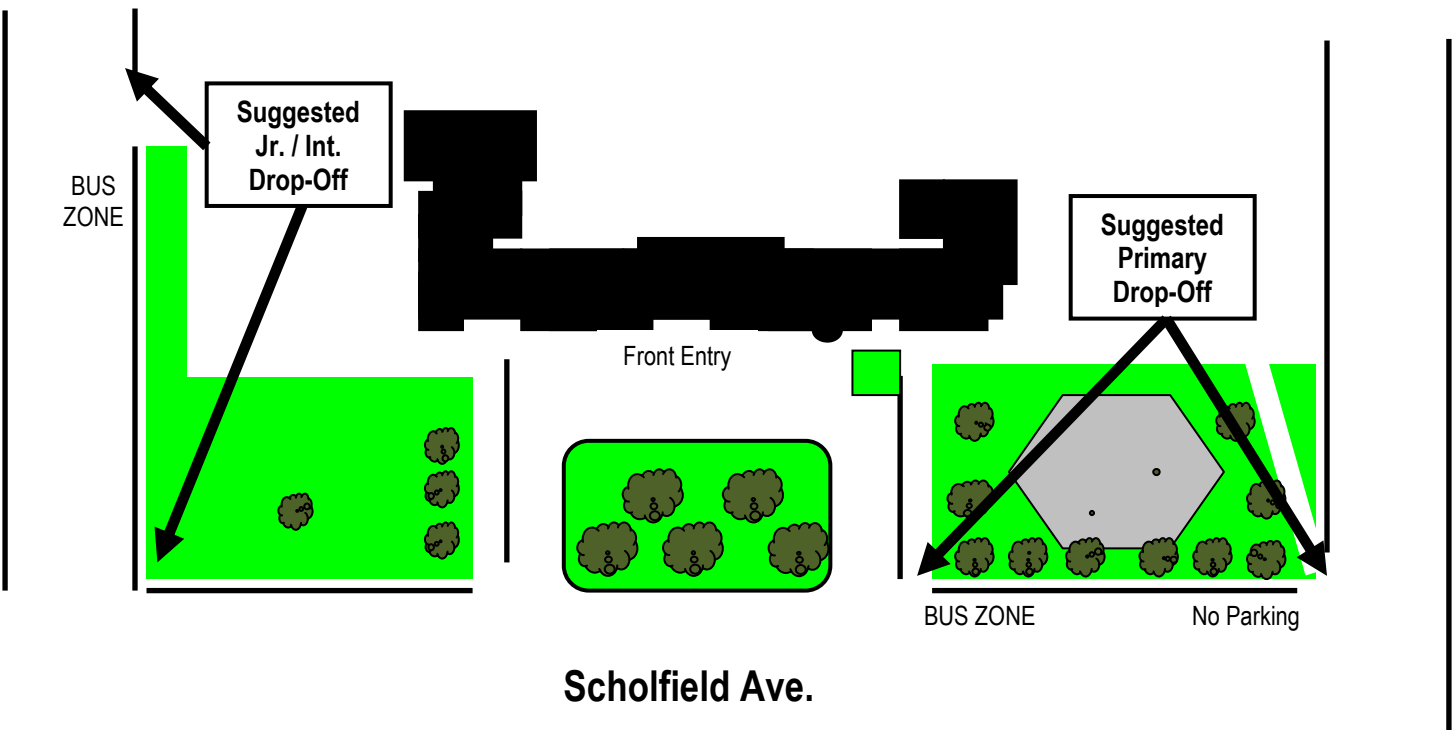


Follow parking and student drop-off/pick-up rules:

- Park **ONLY** in designated parking spots in the lot and along nearby streets.
- Drop-off students closest to their entry door (**NOT** the front door).
  - o See diagram below
- Students exit using their assigned doors.

Please avoid:

- Parking in the driveway areas, particularly by the front door.
- Parking in the NO-PARKING zones along Scholfield Ave.
- Blocking the bus loading zones on Paul St. AND on Scholfield Ave by the playground.
- Picking up students using the front doors.
- Using parking spaces in the lot for drop-off/pick-up purposes.



Staff supervision in the yard begins at 8:35am with the entry bell at 8:50am. Students can continue to use their regular entry door until the morning announcements begin at 8:55am at which time these doors will be locked.

If traffic patterns do not improve, the parking lot will be blocked off during entry/exit times.
