Vaccine Clinic



School Vaccination Clinic - Tuesday Feb 28 - 9 - 12 am

Niagara Region Public Health (NRPH) will be offering vaccination <u>clinics in participating elementary schools</u>. Parents/legal guardians* are welcome to bring their child to the clinic at their school if they received an <u>immunization</u> notice from NRPH.

Parents should bring their child's immunization record (yellow card) on clinic day. THIS IS NOT A COVID VACCINE CLINIC.

**** NOTE: Students can ONLY attend the clinic located at their own school ****

If unable to attend the school vaccination clinic:

- Contact your child's health care provider
- Call Public Health to book an appointment at a community clinic
- · Check with a local walk-in clinic (call ahead for vaccine availability)

*Parents/legal guardians must accompany the student for them to receive their vaccines. In extenuating circumstances, NRPH&ES can proceed with vaccination if the parent/legal guardian is reachable by phone during the appointment.

1. To distribute the day before your school's vaccination clinic

Reminder – The school vaccination clinic is happening tomorrow in the gym. Parents should bring their child's immunization record (yellow card). Students should:

- Twear a loose-fitting shirt
- Eat breakfast or a snack
